Intro

Santa's Crypto Get-Together (SantaCrypt) started in December 2001 as the first annual Czech and Slovak workshop aiming to facilitate closer cooperation of professionals working in the field of applied cryptography and related areas of security. This get-together of experts is organised in order to foster exchange of information and ideas on past, ongoing, and also future projects. Instructions for Authors

The program committee will accept submissions targeting cryptanalysis, cryptography, security applications of cryptography and other related areas. Proposals should be of 5-15 pages and formatted for anonymous evaluation. Word and LaTeX templates for submissions are also available from the workshop web: <u>http://mkb.buslab.org</u>. Submissions can be written in Czech, Slovak, or English.

Submissions should be mailed to matyas AT fi.muni.cz, and clearly marked either with Subject "SantaCrypt 2010". The final deadline for the submissions is 30^{th} September 2010. Submissions will be evaluated by the program committee and authors will be informed about the evaluation results by 26^{th} October. Camera-ready versions for the workshop proceedings have to be delivered by 18^{th} November.
