#### Intro

Santa's Crypto Get-Together (SantaCrypt) started in 2001 as the first annual Czech and Slovak workshop aiming to facilitate closer cooperation of professionals working in the field of applied cryptography and related areas of security. This get-together of experts is organised in order to foster exchange of information and ideas on past, ongoing, and also future projects. We recognise the need of experts meeting their colleagues without the hassle of taking care of their (potential) customers, bosses and other distracting forces. ;-) The workshop is run in English in the first day and then Czech and Slovak the second day.

The program committee will accept submissions targeting cryptanalysis, cryptography, security applications of cryptography and other related areas. Proposals should be of 5-15 pages and formatted for anonymous evaluation. Submissions should be mailed to matyas AT fi.muni.cz, and clearly marked with Subject "SantaCrypt 2011". The final deadline for the submissions is  $3^{rd}$  October 2011. Submissions will be evaluated by the program committee and authors will be informed about the evaluation results by  $31^{st}$  October. Camera-ready versions for the workshop proceedings have to be delivered by  $14^{th}$  November.
