The program committee will accept submissions targeting cryptanalysis, cryptography, security applications of cryptography and other related areas. Proposals should be of 5-15 pages and formatted for anonymous evaluation. Submissions should be mailed to matyas AT fi.muni.cz, and clearly marked with Subject "SantaCrypt 2016". The final deadline for the submissions is 30<sup>th</sup> September 2016. Submissions will be evaluated by the program committee and authors will be informed about the evaluation results by 31<sup>st</sup> October. Cameraready versions for the workshop proceedings have to be delivered by 13<sup>th</sup> November.
